Proposed Action

The Proposed Action is to modify and extend military training airspace and sea space within the Mariana Islands Range Complex. This action is needed to provide a safer and more efficient training environment and to maintain military readiness.

The Navy analyzed three alternatives in the Draft EA/OEA:

- No Action – current training activities
- Alternative 1 – modify and extend military airspace for public safety and training efficiency
- Alternative 2 – modify and extend military airspace (similar to Alternative 1) and expand the sea space danger zone around Farallon de Medinilla from 10 nautical miles (nm) to 12 nm
